

Citizenship & Employment Precarity Frequently Asked Questions

How will my information remain private and confidential?

- The online survey cannot track the geographic location of the computer/cell/tablet you use to fill out the survey.
- 2. Your name or contact information is not required to complete the survey. We ask for your country of origin, gender identity, age, and other social and demographic information, which cannot identify you personally.
- 3. To receive the Tim Horton's Gift card, you can provide any email.
- 4. The answers you put in the main survey are automatically separated from the email you provide to receive your gift card. This means that your survey information cannot be attached to the email you provide.
- 5. The CEP survey team is bound by the Ethics Review Board at York University and the University of Toronto. They will protect the privacy of this research from any external government body to the full extent of the law.
- 6. Emails gathered will be downloaded onto a secure password-protected server housed at York University. All contact information will be deleted once-a-week.

What are the benefits?

- 1. Survey participants who complete the survey receive a \$10.00 e-gift card.
- 2. Participants have an opportunity to think on all of the work they have done to improve their employment situation and obtain more stable immigration status.
- 3. Participants will contribute information that will inform advocacy and may influence policy to help improve the lives of all newcomers in the GTA.
