What?

An online survey about immigration status and work experiences

Why?

1. To understand how different immigration statuses impact work opportunities and well-being
2. To show the long-term social and economic costs of entering Canada without permanent residence

Who qualifies?

- Arrived in Canada in or since 1997 (& have lived here at least three years)
- Between 16 – 45 years old at time of arrival
- First arrived in Canada as a:
 - ✓ Temporary foreign worker
 - ✓ International student
 - ✓ Refugee claimant or refugee (GAR/PSR)
 - ✓ Visitor or without status
- Current Permanent residents and/or Canadian Citizens who arrived in Canada with one of the immigration status categories listed above
- Work at least 20 hours per week (& have worked at least 6 out of last 9 months)
- Live in the Greater Toronto Area
